

PCB Investigation Update for April 7, 2006:

We bring you the latest developments in the ongoing investigation and elimination of the PCBs found in the 10 Mile Drainage District and the Lange and Revere Canals.

Jeff Kimble, the Environmental Protection Agency's field representative assigned to the case, reports that the EPA HAS RECEIVED quotes on the liner that will be used to seal cracks in the existing sewer pipe. It is believed that the ongoing PCB contamination is filtering into the sewer through these cracks. The liner would correct the problem

The EPA plans to select a contractor by the end of the week. Hopefully, the City, the County and the EPA will meet to work out the final details before the end of the month. Watch the SCSTV Comcast Channel 5 and WideOpenWest Channel 10 for future developments.
