## NOTICE OF MEETING WATER RESOURCES & ADVISORY BOARD AMENDED AGENDA

5. ~~Canal Case #07-2021 – Great Lakes Docks and Decks on behalf of James Brockway – 22625 Bayview Dr – Install one 8' x 8' side lift hoist and one 15' x 11' cradle hoist. (Tabled from 3/2/21 Water Resources Meeting)~~ **MOVED TO 5/6/21 AT PETITIONER'S REQUEST.**
6. Lake Case #10-2021 – BC Marine Construction on behalf of Mario and Susan Como – 22576 Ardmore Park – Install 58' of replacement seawall within 12" of existing seawall. Backfill as needed with clean material obtained from an upland source. **(Tabled from 3/2/21 Water Resources Meeting)**
7. Lake Case #11-2021 – Maritime Marine for James Ciesliga – 29450 Jefferson – Install one 5-post hoist and 2 pilings at the terminal end of the existing dock.
8. Canal Case #12-2021 – Bayside Marine Construction for Donald Harris – 22673 Bayview – Install 20' long by 12' wide by 9.5' deep (84 cubic yard) boat hoist to facilitate boat storage capabilities onsite.
9. Lake Case #13-2021 – Marine One LTD for SHM Jefferson Beach LLC – 24400 Jefferson – Execute the following work within the Jefferson Beach Marina basin over five years, as needed, install 4,400 linear feet of replacement steel seawall, no more than 1' waterward of the existing seawall. Discharge approximately 1,303 cubic yards of clean fill in 4,400' long by 1' wide area landward of the new seawall. Maintain

approximately 740 existing docks, 34-60 foot long, by replacing decking in place in kind. Maintain and replace as needed approximately 2,500 existing spring pilings throughout the marina. Install 32 steel pilings within the 530 square foot covered boat well area. Install new dock, 133' long by 8' wide, using existing pilings and adding pilings as necessary.
