NOTICE OF MEETING WATER RESOURCES & ADVISORY BOARD - AMENDED

There will be a meeting of the Water Resources & Advisory Board on June 1, 2021 at **7:00 p.m.** in the Geer Conference Room at City Hall, 27600 Jefferson Avenue, St. Clair Shores, Michigan.

The agenda will be as follows:

4. Approval of May 4, 2021 Meeting Minutes
5. Lake Case #13-2021 – Marine One LTD for SHM Jefferson Beach LLC – 24400 Jefferson – Execute the following work within the Jefferson Beach Marina basin over five years, as needed, install 4,400 linear feet of replacement steel seawall, no more than 1' waterward of the existing seawall. Discharge approximately 1,303 cubic yards of clean fill in 4,400' long by 1' wide area landward of the new seawall. Maintain approximately 740 existing docks, 34-60 foot long, by replacing decking in place in kind. Maintain and replace as needed approximately 2,500 existing spring pilings throughout the marina. Install 32 steel pilings within the 530 square foot covered boat well area. Install new dock, 133' long by 8' wide, using existing pilings and adding pilings as necessary. **Amended request to include replacement of Docks A, B, and C with floating docks. (Tabled from 5/4/21 Water Resources Meeting.)**
6. Canal Case #16-2021 – Bayside Marine on behalf of Michael Monaghan – 22640 Bayview – Install 17' of steel seawall. Install a 10,000 lb side lift hoist.
7. Lake Case #17-2021 – Huron Pointe Excavating on behalf of Frederick Morley – 33930 Jefferson – Install a new dock, 90' long by 4' wide, with an 8' by 8' dogleg at the south waterward end. Install a 12' by 13' covered boat hoist. The roof structure is proposed to be 18' wide by 32' in length. Install 8 spring piles and 2 cluster pile ice breakers as shown on the plans.
8. Canal Case #18-2021 – B.C. Marine on behalf of William Roland – 22513 Rio Vista – Remove existing catwalk within upland cut boat well. Remove 6 wood pilings within

upland cut boat well. Install one 13' x 12' boat hoist within the upland cut boat well. Install 12 steel pilings adjacent to existing seawall.

9. Canal Case #19-2021 – John Rackham – 22565 Shorewood Dr. – Installation of side lift boat hoist. Installing two W8 x 15# I-Beams in front of the wall. Cable drum will be mounted to two 6" Sch40 pipes driven into the ground on the back side of the wall.
10. Any other business that may properly come before the Board.
