

**MINUTES
ST. CLAIR SHORES CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
JUNE 15, 2019**

Special Meeting of the City Council, held in the Council Chambers, located at 27600 Jefferson Avenue, St. Clair Shores, Michigan.
