# VOTERS

## Register to vote on Election Day

Through October 18th	October 18th through November 2nd	Election Day November 2nd
<b>Register:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Online at: <a href="http://michigan.gov/vote">michigan.gov/vote</a></li><li>• Any Secretary of State branch office</li><li>• Your city or county clerk's office</li><li>• A designated state agency</li><li>• By mail (must be postmarked by 10/18/21)</li></ul>	<b>Register:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>In person</i> at your city clerk's office</li></ul>	<b>Register and Vote:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>In person</i> at your city clerk's office before 8 pm</li><li>• You may vote that day</li></ul>

**Residency verification required**  
*Acceptable documents include:*

- Driver's license
- State ID card
- Current utility bill
- Bank statement
- Paycheck
- Government check
- Other government document or ID

*Documents must have name and current address.*  
*Digital copies are acceptable.*

## All voters now can vote by Absentee

**Step 1: Request your ballot.** Get application at county and city clerks' offices or at [Michigan.gov/Vote](http://Michigan.gov/Vote).

Ballots will be sent by mail for any ballot application received by **5 pm the Friday before an election (Oct 29)**.

Absentee ballots after this date will only be issued *in person* at their clerk's office.

Voters can bring in their application and receive a ballot

- 8 am - 7 pm on Thurs. Oct. 28th
- 8 am - 4 pm on Sat. before the Election (Oct 30)
- 8 am - 4 pm on the Mon. before Election Day (Nov 1)
- Election Day (Nov 2) 7 am till 8 pm - New Voters Only can register and receive a ballot at their clerk's office.

**Step 2: Complete, Sign, & Submit**

- **Option 1:** Drop off completed ballot in person to your city clerk. Election Drop Boxes located in the front and rear of City Hall.
- **Option 2:** Return your ballot to your clerk through the mail.

**The outer Ballot Envelope must be SIGNED & received by 8 pm on Election Day.**
